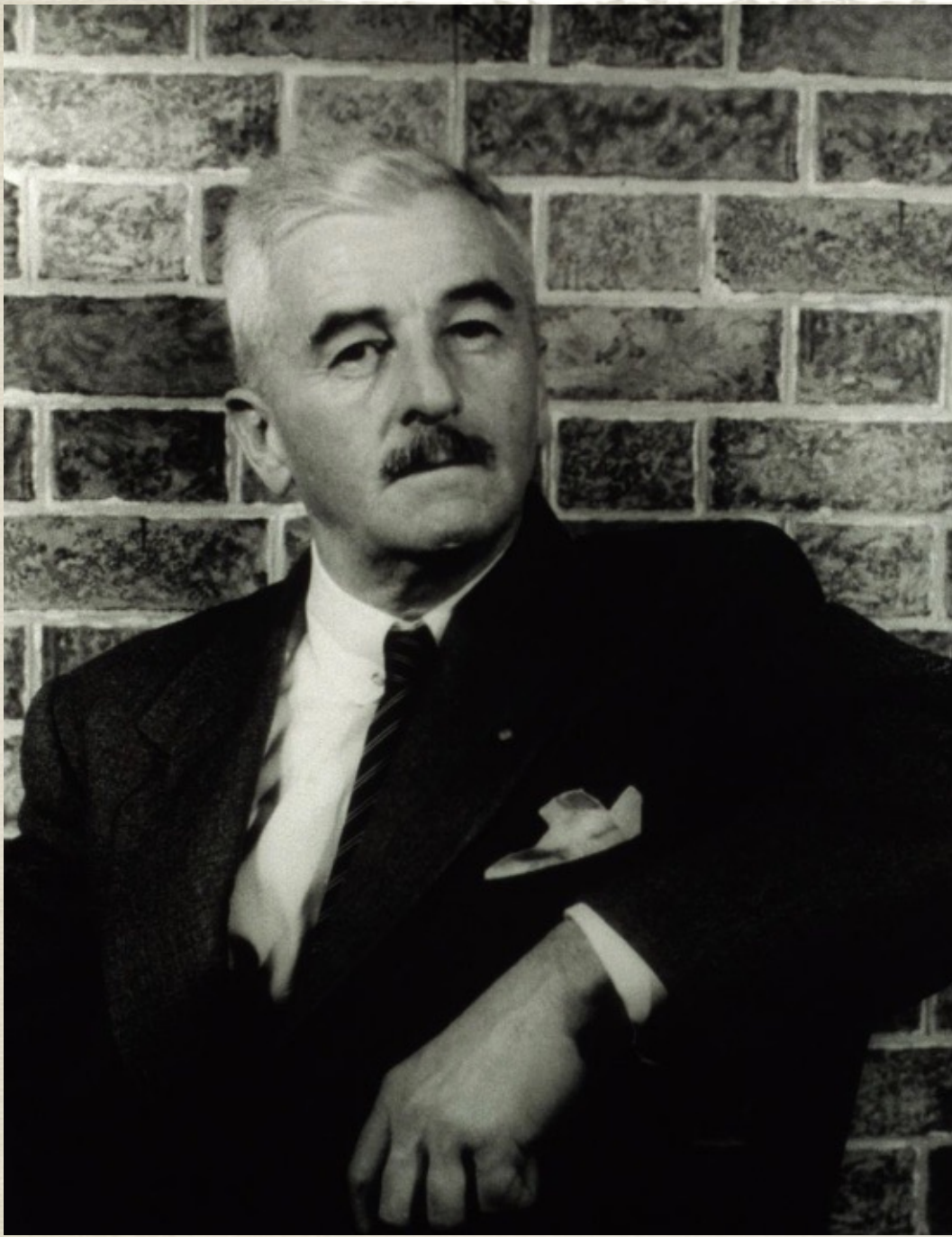

“Smoking kills. If you’re killed, you’ve lost a very important part of your life.”

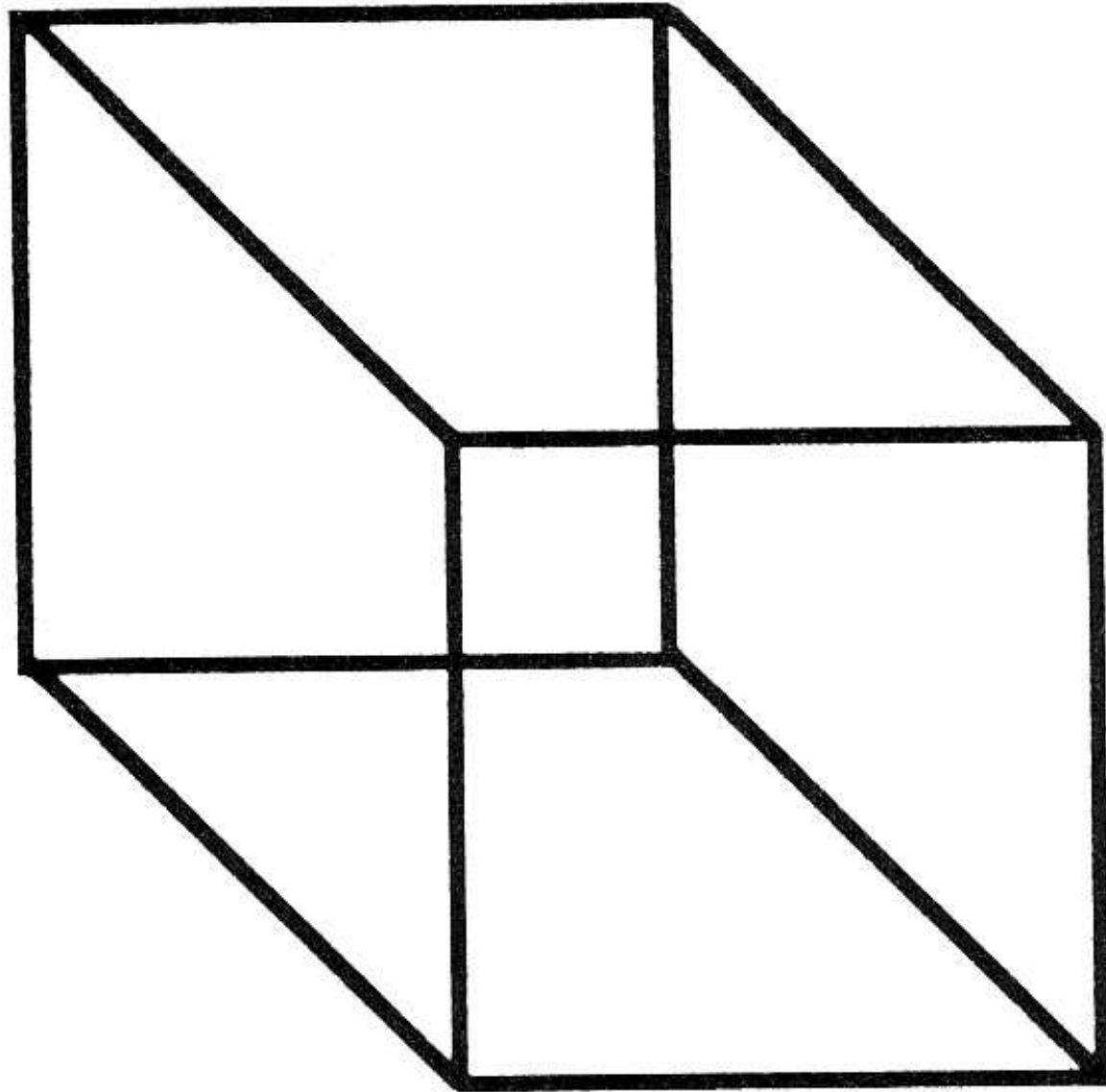

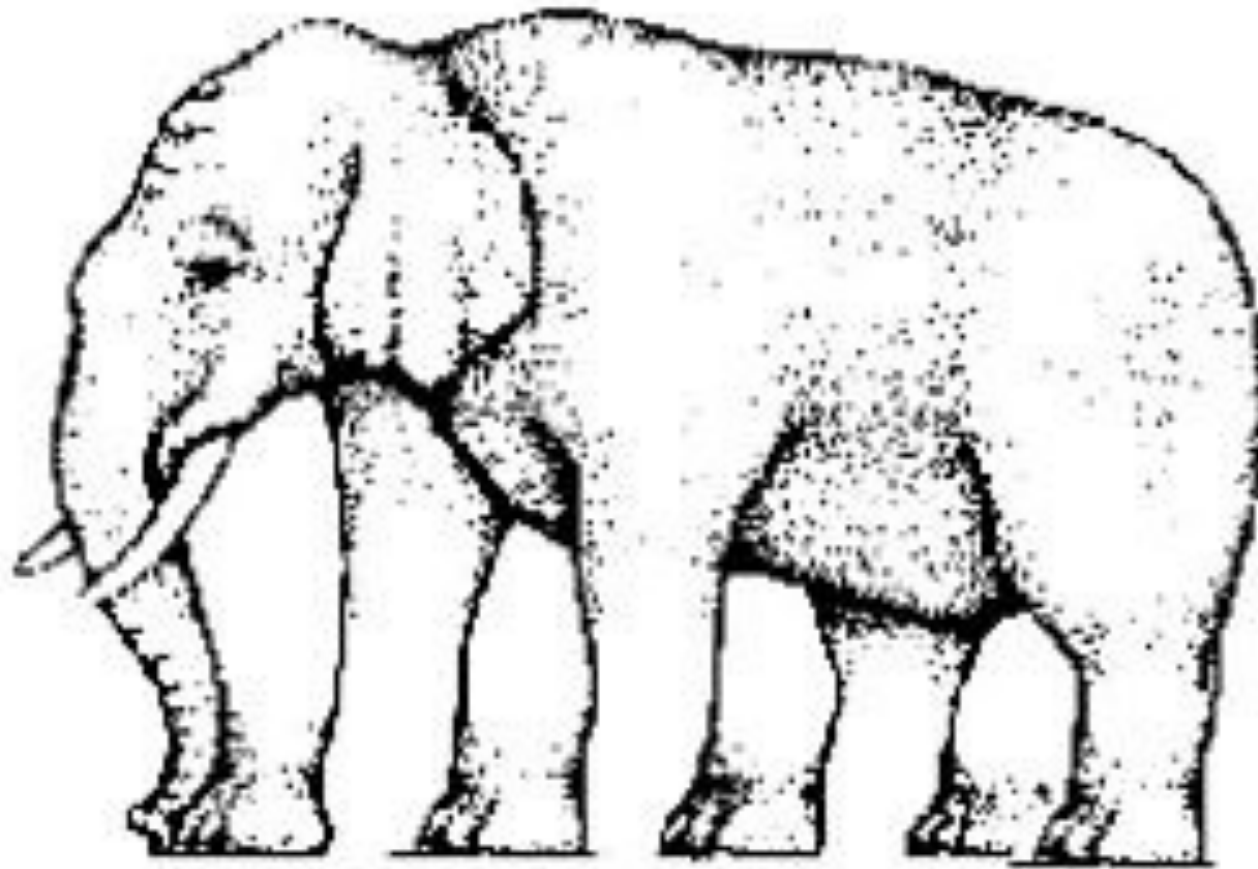

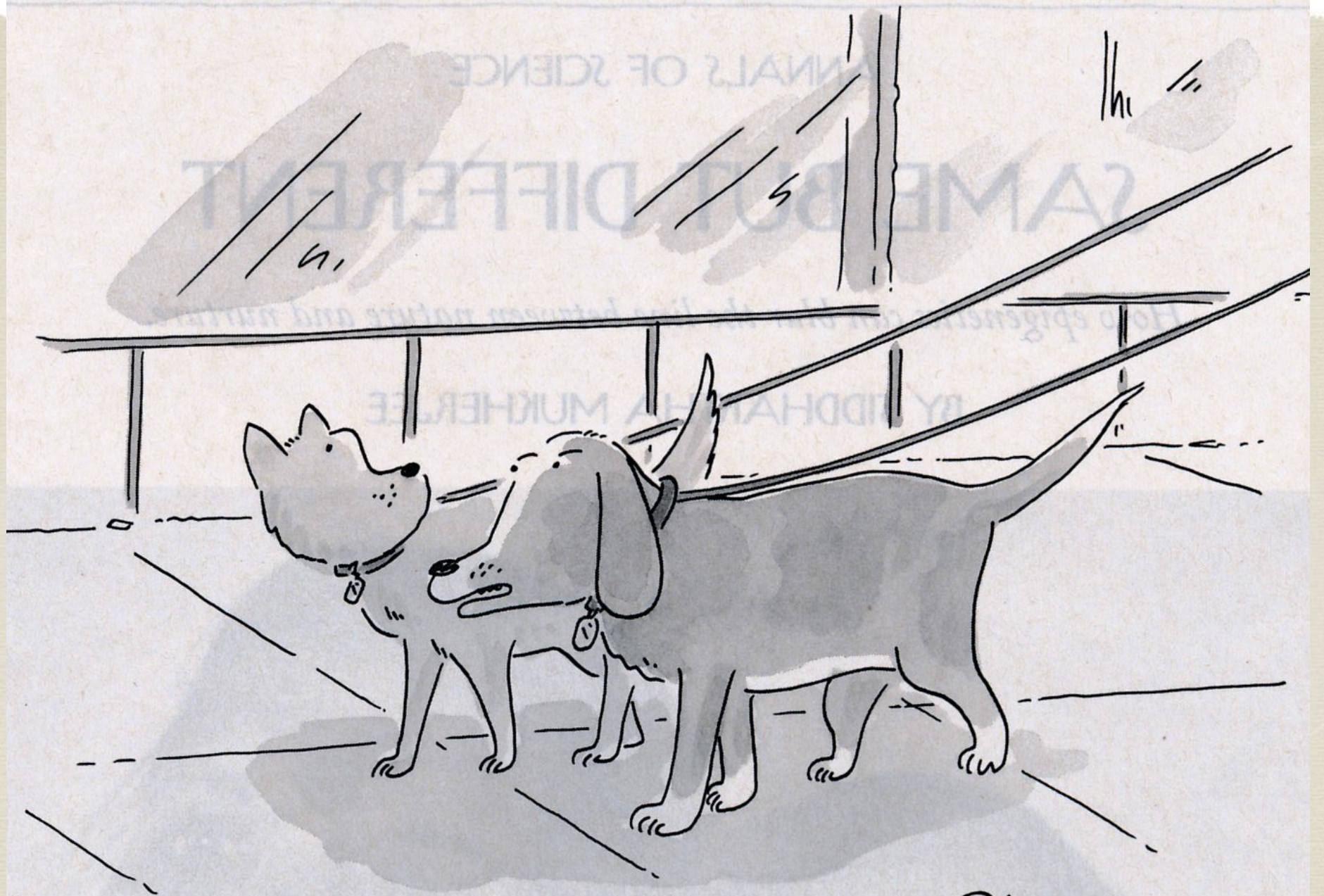

The moment we identify with either one of these characters, we are “guilty of the sin of the other one.”

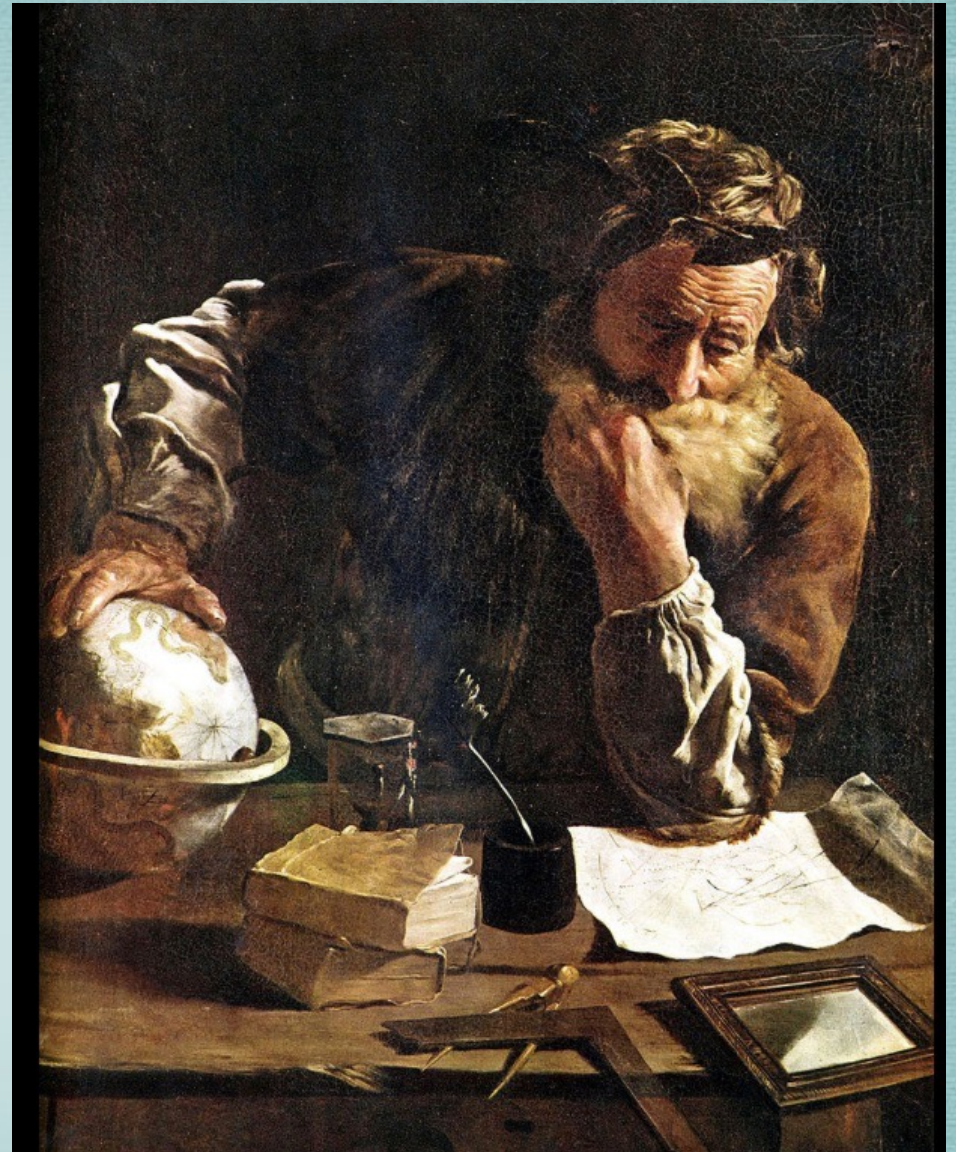
