






Your Enneagram Stance is determined by which Center of Intelligence is Repressed: Thinking, Feeling, or Doing




Your Enneagram Triad is determined by which Center of Intelligence is Dominant: Thinking, Feeling, or Doing




Movement in Stress & Security

Move with the arrow in Stress Move against the arrow in Security
















As an internationally recognized Enneagram Master, Suzanne has conducted over 800 Enneagram workshops over the past 30 years.
