then you will enter in.”

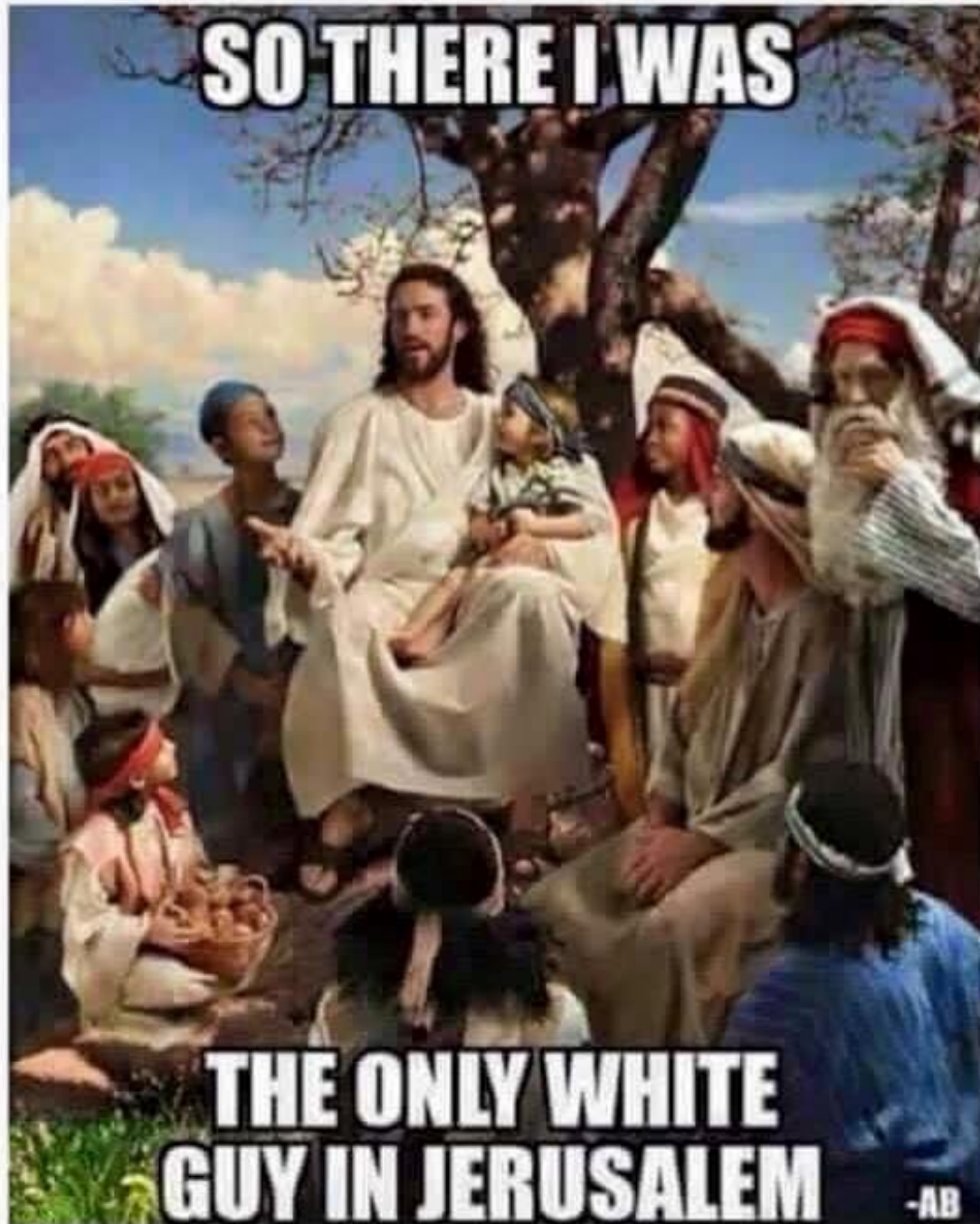
The theme of Thomas is

fragmentation.



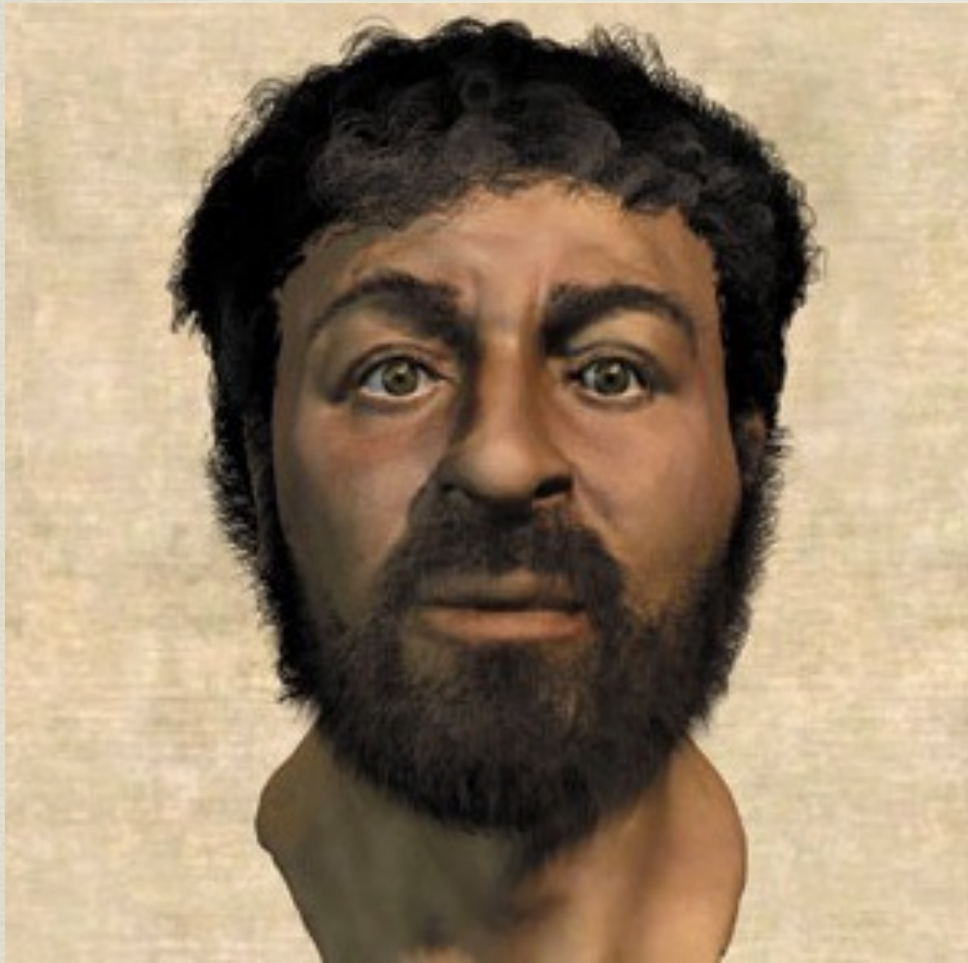
