
Ordinary Life







6 Stages of FAITH DEVELOPMENT



James Fowler's Religious Development

- Stage 1. Intuitive-projective faith (early childhood) invent images of good & evil
- Stage 2. Mythical-literal faith (middle and late childhood) reason in more
- Stage 3. Synthetic-conventional faith (between childhood & adolescence) coherent belief system
- Stage 4. Individuating-reflexive faith (between adolescence & adulthood) responsibility for their religious beliefs
- Stage 5. Conjunctive faith (middle adulthood). few to this stage: being more open to paradox & opposing viewpoints
- Stage 6. Universalizing faith (middle or late adulthood) transcending specific belief systems to achieve sense of oneness with all being
