no one is searching out anything.

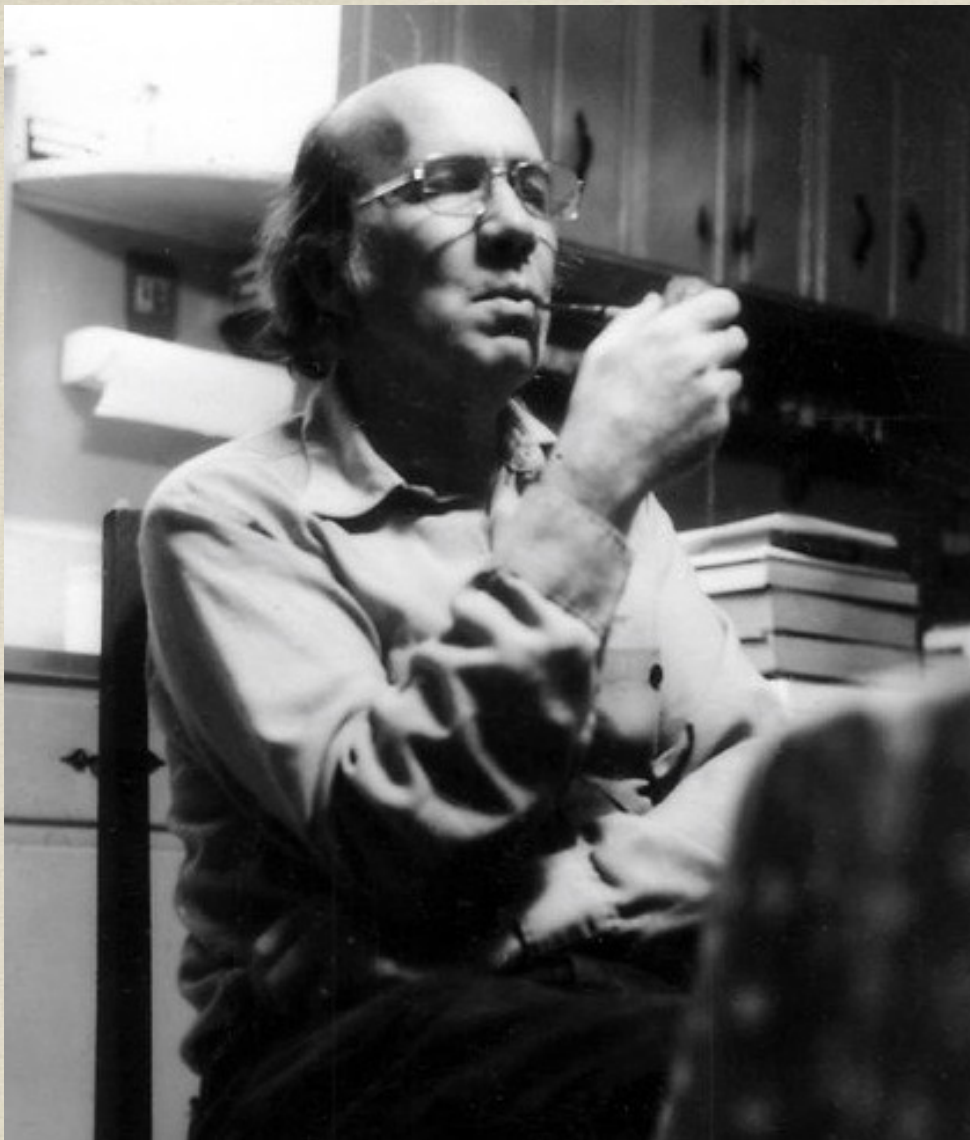

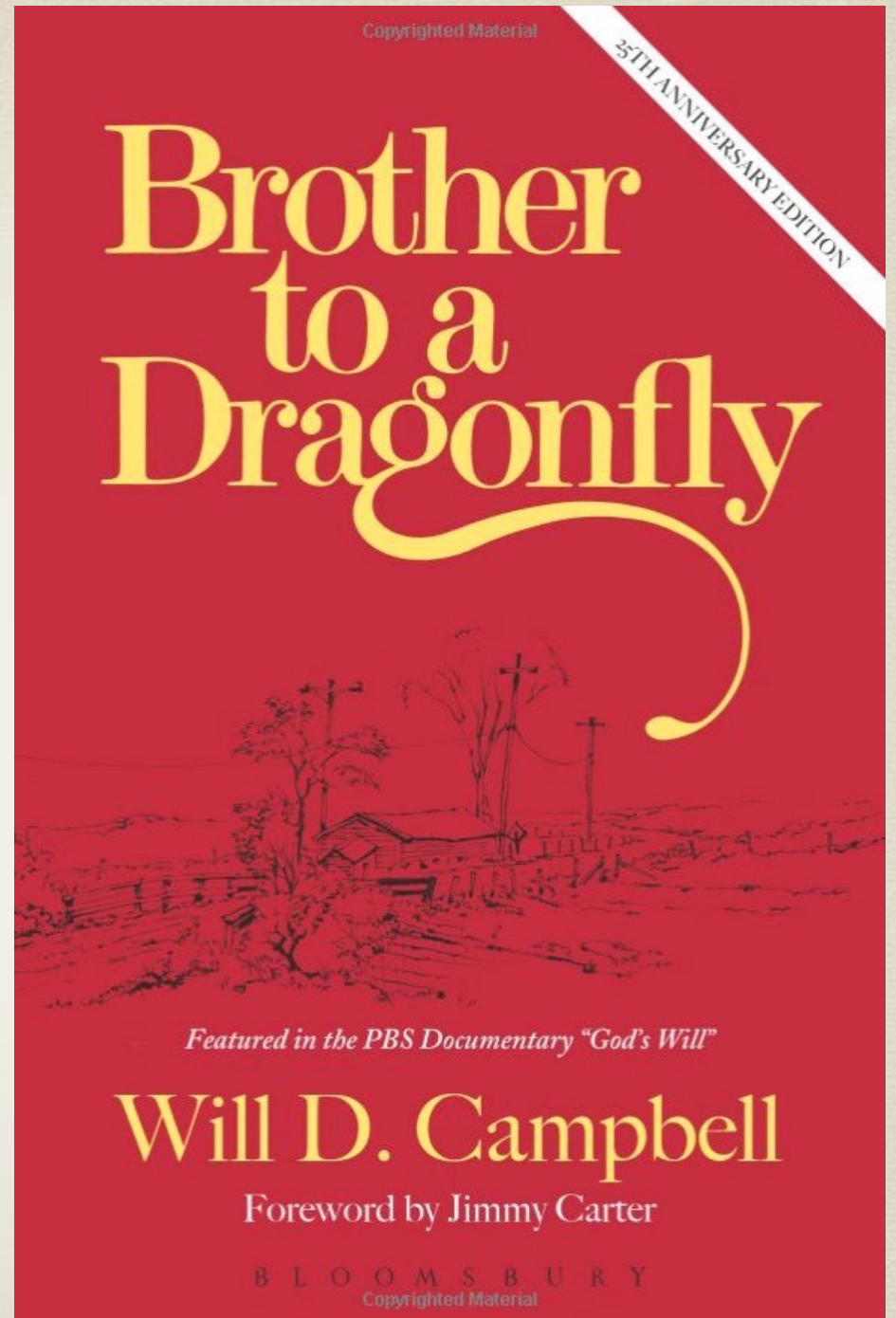
